Minutes

Motion by *Stefan* to approve 2023 AGM minutes, seconded by *Torsten*; **Carried**

- President's welcome and good-bye Werner addressed the group and gave an overview of the school's history - see accompanying PowerPoint for report. Werner was thanked for his continuous leadership over the past years.
- Director's report Ralf see accompanying PowerPoint for report
 - Of note: Enrollment numbers are similar to last year; there are 8 youth classes this year compared to 11 last year
 - VGS has three new teachers; Christian, Christine and Stefan
 - o After 2024, PASCH will no longer exist
 - Sprachbeihilfe (German government financial support) has been significantly decreased, not just for VGS, but all schools in Western Canada
- **Treasurer's report** Tamino reviewed breakdown of annual revenues and expenses. See accompanying PowerPoint for details
 - 2023/24 Balance Sheet and Income Statement were printed and distributed to attendees for review
 - o Tamino gave an overview of the VGS' financial environment over the past 5 years, to illustrate the impact Covid-19 had on the school.

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- Especially given the decreased financial support from the German Government, there was some discussion about securing the financial health of the school for the future.
- Arelia raised the point that as a charitable organization, VGS can issue charitable receipts for donations, and that feature should be promoted.
- Discussion about other fundraising efforts, e.g. approaching Germanbased businesses
- Stefan raised the point that the staff works very hard and is being paid at outdated wage levels, and new board should consider staff wages.
- Arelia asked about measuring the satisfaction health of the school, whether the teachers and parents are happy. Stefan reminded attendees that Deborah set up a survey in 2019. If a new survey was developed and distributed, data from both surveys can be compared. General support to solicit more feedback from parents and teachers.
- Discussion about low turnout to meetings, like the AGM. Suggestion to print notices to give to children, and also to ensure important messages are sent to both parents via email.
- o Suggestion to include calendar event with email, or attach calendar.
- Question about exploring free advertising, like a poster to put up at St Barnabas church during their events.
- Action item Stefan will produce fliers about VGS to distribute at St Martin event
- Suggestion about ways to encourage families or parents to get together more often, such as more coffee mornings
- Discussion about alternative methods to reach families, besides email, such as Whatsap groups
